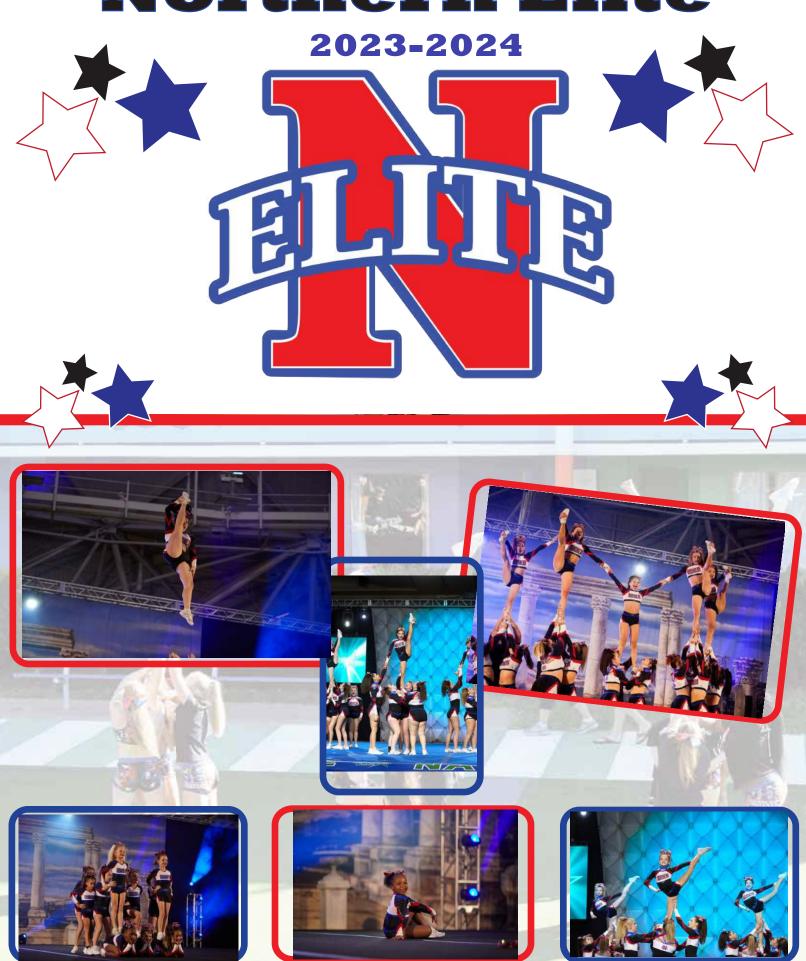

Join Us For Tryouts

With countless titles and top notch quality, Northern Elite is not just considered the BEST program in Minnesota, but is nationally the most recognized and most successful gym from our region.

Our full season athletes are ages 5+, and no experience is necessary to tryout. The tryout process is low pressure and fun! The athletes demonstrate jumps, tumbling skills, and choreography. They meet the staff and new friendships are formed.

We can't wait for you to experience it for yourself to truly understand the dynamics, traditions and success of our Northern Elite family.

Tryout Details

Our tryout process will be different than previous seasons. Athletes will be assigned practice groups with the letters A-F. Athletes new to NE will need to register for a 20-minute appointment with one of our directors. These appointments will be small group evaluations to evaluate tumbling and jump skills. They will then be assigned a practice group. Should an athlete be assigned 2 groups, they will need to attend at least 1 of each.

Returning NE athletes can request a practice group assignment from their previous coach, Carin (owner), or Directors (Steven and Amanda). However, if they'd like to sign up for an appointment to evaluate any new skills they may have, they are welcome to.

Mandatory Parent Meetings

Athletes will be sized at these meetings for uniforms and practice wear.

Sunday, June 4th

12pm-1:30pm Prep Teams

Practices begin on June 5th.

Tryout Registration Costs:

\$350 must be paid at registration.

The tryout fee includes: 1. Annual NE Registration Fee (\$50), 2. Tryout Fee (\$50) and 3. Non-Refundable Deposit* (\$250). The non-refundable deposit will be applied to the June payment.

Athletes must have their USASF Membership paid by 7/15. Athlete Membership Fee is \$49, and \$75 for adult athletes. (Costs are tentative and are subject to change.) Returning athletes will not be eligible to tryout with a balance from the 2022-2023 season.

*Athletes that we are unable to place due to age requirements will be refunded the annual registration fee and deposit. No other exceptions will be made.

Note- We are including a deposit into our tryout fees because we firmly believe that the success of a team begins on Day 1 when teams are placed. Previously we have had athletes attend tryouts to see what team they would make and then quit the teams after being placed. This deposit is a way to reduce the likelihood of this happening and is to benefit all families' investment and protect the quality of teams placed.

REGISTRATION BEGINS ON APRIL 1, 2023.

Team Contracts are due at initial evaluation or prior to receive practice group assignment.

Placements



Restructuring of Competitive Program:

Allstar Cheer is still very new in terms of being a competitive sport and the growth in just the last 2 decades is astounding. Expectations of athlete skills at each level have risen over recent years- in both technique and difficulty.

In order to not only increase but maintain our level of competitiveness (locally, regionally, and nationally), we need to have our athletes in the gym more to work on the skills required of each individual and team.

Our Elite teams will still continue to be in the gym twice a week during the summer months. During the school year, there will be two regular practices per week plus a mandatory 1.5 hour practice that will focus on tumbling, jumps, and flexibility. These teams will be placed with athletes we feel showcase mastered skills for their competitive level and are looking to compete on teams with a high level of commitment.

Full season prep teams will now be known as Prep+ and these teams will be at the gym two nights a week and compete at 1-2 regional events in addition to their local events. These teams may also be considered for end of season prep team travel events. Our intention for the 23'-24' season is to have teams compete in prep divisions at multiple levels. Prep+ will be closer to our current elite structure- with less travel commitments.

Local Prep will be in the gym one night per week and compete in prep divisions. These teams will ONLY compete locally. These teams will be similar to our current prep team structure.

With this planned restructuring, we anticipate team placements to be more regimented and placement to our Elite teams to be more difficult. With the rise in expectations, we conversely expect there to be a shift in numbers from Elite to Prep+ teams. Similarly, expectations for our Prep+ athletes will also be increased.

While costs continue to rise, not only in this sport but across all industries, you will note that we did our best to keep costs as relatively similar as possible compared to previous seasons. However, as competition fees are still the largest cost of our season, this will likely result in less overall events to keep our team pricing at a similar rate. We would prefer to work within a lower budget, than stretch our families thin financially.

By refocusing more attention to furthering athlete development, we believe each team will have more time to focus on achieving their goals in a slightly more relaxed environment due to the extended time with our team athletes.

When registering for tryouts, please talk with your athletes about the questionnaire. These questionnaires will be vital to our staff finding the best fit for every athlete.

Additionally, in an effort to eliminate crossovers while wanting to guide our most dedicated athletes to the next level, we will be introducing Alternates. These athletes will be assigned to higher level teams as a substitute athlete. They will practice with teams all season and fill in for missing athletes in stunt groups when needed, but will only compete with them when necessary for cases of injury or illness to a primary team member. These athletes will pay a reduced monthly fee for their 2nd team.

Team Placement:

Athletes are placed on a team at the discretion of the coaches. Age, ability, and experience are all factors. Please understand that athletes may be repositioned, moved or replaced at any time. Any changes made are to benefit the team as a whole.

There may be athletes on any given team that tumble at a different level than the rest of their teammates. We try to match up the athletes by level as best we can, but please remember that stunting, pyramids, jumps, dance, motions and age are huge factors as well. Some will be stronger tumblers than others. Some will contribute more with stunts than others. We choose our teams based on the positions that we need to fill (Bases, flyers, tumblers, etc.). Every athlete is on the team for a reason – please trust our staff. Our teams have continuously and consistently been successful.

Process:

The tryout process is very casual and fun! The athletes demonstrate jumps, tumbling skills, and choreography. We evaluate the athletes in groups and encourage each person to do their best! After tryouts, the staff will pick teams based on their discretion. Many key elements factor into the decision. Keep in mind all NE teams are built to compete at the highest level.

Registration:

If you already have an account:

If you don't have an account:

You should first create your account as a parent. Once your account is created, you can go login and add your athlete

by clicking "Participants" on the left hand side, and then selecting "Add Participant".

Note: Do not use your email for your athlete. Either leave blank, or use an alternative.

Once this has been done, you will be able to register your athlete.

Fees

A schedule of payments is listed in this packet. All monthly fees are due the 1st of the month. Please direct all payments to the payment box located on the lower end of the reception desk. Please make all checks payable to Northern Elite. Credit card payments can be made online (+ additional 3% processing fee). A \$25 fee will be applied to all returned checks. If payment is not received by the 5th of every month, your credit card will be charged on the next business day (+additional 3% processing fee). If the card is declined, your athlete will not participate and may be moved to alternate status. Additionally, a \$35 late fee will be applied. We are not responsible for lost cash payments. Please contact the office directly if you need to discuss payment options. Monthly tuition will not be pro-rated for any reason and all fees are non-refundable. Any athlete that decides to not to finish out the season with Northern Elite after choreography for any reason, will be assessed a \$250 termination fee.

<u>Travel Accomodations</u>

All travel expenses for out-of-state competitions are the responsibility of each family. Many competitions require us to stay at select hotels. For those competitions, we will try to offer different options for families and you will be able to choose the best fit for your family. You will be able to book in our designated room blocks through a housing website.

Competition Schedule

Our competition schedule outline will be released on 7/15. Typically our competitions schedule runs from November-Mid March. Prep+ teams will have local, plus 2-3 regional events. Elite teams will compete a mix of events locally, plus regionally/nationally. Local Prep will only participate in-state events. Our competition schedule will be set to work within the budget that we are setting prior to our 2023-2024 season beginning. This may mean that we don't do as many events as we have in the past. The rising costs across all industries has made it difficult for us to keep within our budget, yet we feel it is important to do our best to keep cheer as affordable as possible for our families.

When is the gym closed?

WHAT IS A TEAM PARENT?

A Team Parent is a parent who is the liaison between the coach and the parents. The Team Parents are in charge of meeting the team at competitions, planning team events, assisting with team functions and communication. Team Parents are not involved in gym decisions, coaching, or accounting issues. As a parent, you will receive information mostly through email and the BAND App via Team Parents, Coaches, and Owner. These are the suggested tumbling skills for each level. We do look at athletes' potential and their overall abilities (stunting, jumps, etc) but nearly every athlete will have all of the appropriate skills for their level and some of the advanced skills. They will be able to perform them with consistency and with good technique.

Code Of Conduct

If you have any questions or concerns that need immediate attention, please use the following chain of command:

- 1. Team Rep
- 2. Head Coach
- 3. Program Director
- 4. Owner

Northern Elite maintains the right to refuse services to anyone at any time.

NE is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

If an athlete is moved to alternate status, your tuition will remain the same, and you are expected to attend all team practices and local competitions.

NO GOSSIP about a child on your team or another team.

NO GOSSIP about coaches and staff. It is much better to address a problem than to listen to idle gossip.

Our gym is a positive environment. Negative behavior and comments are not welcome in the gym, the lobby, or outside of the gym.

Please keep in mind the gym is not a babysitting service. We want our athletes to use the gym as often as possible, but no child should be dropped off at the gym unsupervised or left waiting to be picked up. Athletes not picked up within 15 minutes of their practices end time will be charged for a 30-minute private.

Practices may be modified or added at any time during the season.

Anyone threatening to quit or to pull their child from a team will be dismissed from the program immediately.

Only cheerleaders and coaches are allowed in the gym.

Families are not allowed to yell onto the floor or try to make contact through the viewing area window during practices or classes.

The coaches reserve the right to close practices at ANY time for ANY reason.

It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to know what is going on with your team. Check your emails and the Band App regularly.

Withholding a child from a practice or a competition should never be used as a form of punishment.

Athletes should be able to handle school, work, practices, and events. Homework, studying, work, etc. is not an acceptable excuse for missing practice. An important aspect of extracurricular activities is the emphasis on time management.

If a problem arises between an athlete and a teammate or another parent, the problem will be addressed with all parties involved at a meeting with your coach/allstar director and/or owner.

If a problem arises between parents, it is expected that it will be handled outside of the gym and is not a responsibility of NE.

Anonymous emails/letters/texts/twitter mentions, etc. will be ignored.

The NE logo, Name, and Team Names/Logos are a trademark and you may not use it without permission from Carin Moore.

Northern Elite has a zero-tolerance policy for drugs, alcohol, and tobacco. Any athletes found to be in possession/using drugs, alcohol, or tobacco at the NE facility or competition may immediately be removed from the program.

Text or Email is the preferred method of communication with the coaching staff. In-person or phone calls should be previously scheduled with the coaches via text or email. Please be respectful to keep all communication within reasonable hours (Avoid early mornings and late nights).

Food and drinks are NOT allowed in the locker room. Athletes found violating this rule will be required to volunteer 1 hour of cleaning or miscellaneous tasks.

Athlete Expectations

Good sportsmanship, polite manners and a good disposition are mandatory at all practices and competitions.

Athletes should arrive at scheduled practices 15 minutes prior to start time.

Code Of Conduct



It is your responsibility to wear the appropriate practice wear to every practice. Athletes that fail to wear the assigned practice wear will be required to stay after practice for 15 minutes and complete an assignment from the coaches. Examples: putting equipment away, cleaning the locker room, stretching, jumping, conditioning, etc.

Personal items such as cell phones, school bags, or gym bags must be stored in the locker room. No items are to be left in the gym hallways and cell phones must be turned off and stored when practice starts.

You must arrive at all practices, competitions or any scheduled event on time. Punctuality is a MUST. Tardy athletes will be required to stay after practice for 15 minutes and complete an assignment from the coaches. Examples: putting equipment away, cleaning the locker room, stretching, jumping, conditioning, etc.

Please feel free to talk to your coach about anything; remember to do it at the appropriate time. For example, approaching a coach in the middle of a practice would not be an appropriate time.

Any behavioral issues that pertain to NE will result in 1 verbal and 1 written warning before being dismissed from the program.

Athletes with symptoms of any illness may be required to wear a mask at practice.

Competitions

We look at the athletes in our program as brand ambassadors. Sportsmanship and respectable behavior are of the utmost importance at competitions. Failure to adhere to this guideline will be treated with the same consequences as a behavioral issue.

Athletes are required to be at all practices leading up to a competition. Failure to attend the 2 practices prior to a competition may result in the athlete being pulled from the routine. Any awards/bids received during this time may be forfeited by the athlete. The athlete will be added back to the routine at the convenience of the coaching staff.

Athletes are required to stay/arrive at competitions to support the teams assigned to them, as well as their awards session. Any exception must be approved by Carin Moore no later than one week prior to the event. Consequences of not following this rule will result in one of the following three consequences:

- 1. Removal from next competition
- 2. \$100 fine
- 3. 3 volunteer hours to be completed within one month.

*If the next competition is followed by a competition the following weekend, the athlete will be removed from both. Athletes are still expected to attend the competition, unless approved by Carin Moore.

Competitions are not optional. If an athlete misses a competition for an unexcused reason, their Summit/Worlds eligibility may be forfeited. Examples of an excused miss would include a death/funeral, serious injuries/illnesses (at the discretion of NE), or any previously approved absence.

Athletes with any pre-scheduled vacations are responsible for alerting NE at tryouts. Our competition schedule will be released on or by July 15th. We suggest waiting for this to book any travel during the competition season.

Parents, relatives, friends and cheerleaders are never allowed to speak with competition officials for any reason and are never allowed to represent Northern Elite under any circumstances concerning accommodations, competitions, vendors, etc.

Travel to and from an out of state competition on the day of competition is NOT allowed without prior approval from Carin Moore.

Injury

Athletes need to be able to physically and mentally perform all aspects of competitive cheerleading. Please review our injury policy provided in this tryout packet.

Athletes with chronic injuries/illness may be moved to alternate status at any time. It is our belief that we owe it to our program, teams, and families to make sure our teams are competing as close to 100% capacity at every competition.

Social Media

Social media posts that include the NE logo in any form must be professional. No profanity or inappropriate behavior can be included.

Additionally, NE athletes found using abusive/inappropriate behavior on social media (excessive swearing, inappropriate pictures, pictures showing drugs/alcohol) will receive 1 verbal warning and 1 written warning, before being removed from the program.

Never post any negative comments on social media about our program or ANY program.

Attendance/Injury Policies



Athlete Injury Policy

As an organization, Northern Elite takes the safety of our athletes very seriously. We have decided to formally outline our policy to our members and ask that everyone signs and dates this form to ensure all athletes and families are in understanding of our process.

Should an athlete find themselves injured and unable to function fully at a practice, they must immediately inform their coach and will be asked to completely sit out of the remainder of practice.

At the following practice, the athlete must have a doctor's note outlining their limitations or inability to practice. Should the note not include a specific timeline of when the athlete is able to fully participate, we require that the athlete brings in another doctor's note clearing them to return to practice.

Athletes must fully participate in both practices prior to a competition in order to compete. If they do not have clearance from a doctor to participate in both practices, they will not be allowed to compete.

Note: While we are sensitive to our athlete's safety, we still believe in making the best decisions for the team as a whole. If changes are made to a routine due to an athlete not participating, the routine may or may not change back to its original form. Changes are made at the coaches' discretion.

Attendance Policy

1. Athletes will start with: Elite 12 points, Prep + 10 Points, Prep Local 8 Points.

(Late starters will be given 1 less point based on month. Example: If an athlete joins in July, they'll be given 9 points. August would be 8 points, and so on.)

Summer Practices: 1 point
Absences during school year practice schedule: 2 Points
Tardy (15+ minutes) and Elite Conditioning Practices: .5 Point

- 2. Every point ABOVE TWELVE will result in a \$20 penalty added to your account.
- 3. There are NO EXCUSED absences or tardies.
- 4. Athletes MUST be fully participating and in attendance at the 2 practices prior to a competition. In rare circumstances, teams may be able to adjust their practice schedule to ensure compliance.
- 5. Athletes will be assessed a \$50 fee for missed competitions- unless previously approved at tryouts or join date.

Northern Elite has taken into account school functions, illness, and family emergencies. We feel that this policy is fair and offers flexibility to our families while still preserving each family's investment. It will be at the discretion of the Program Director/Owner to grant more points for extenuating circumstances.

Just because a family is willing to pay penalties to remain in compliance with the attendance policy, does not mean that there may not be other consequences for poor attendance. Example: Athletes may be removed from spots, stunts, etc. Practice is essential and if athletes aren't able to practice because of one individuals excessive absences, then it is best for the team to find someone that can be more committed.

Athletes that miss competitions may forfeit Summit eligibility.

Points will only be given to missed practices. Competitions are mandatory and athletes are only permitted to miss a competition if it is excused at team placements in June, or whenever the athlete joins.

At Northern Elite we pride ourselves on providing our families with a competition schedule as soon as possible. Typically, our competition schedule will be released by July 15th. However, many times it has been provided when teams are placed at the end of tryouts. We recommend not booking any travel during October-March (regular competition season) between tryouts/placements and the distribution of the competition schedule to avoid any conflicts.
